# Requesting & Using NPLD Fee-Free Coupons

## Register your NPLD event on NEEF's NPLD map

Even if you don't have all the details of your event, make sure to register and request coupons before the **August deadline**.

## Use an address recognized by USPS

NEEF ships via the US Post office, so you must add a recognized mailing address. Check your address here:

## Receive your fee-free coupons

You'll receive your fee-free coupons the week before National Public Lands Day. Please contact <a href="mailto:npld@neefusa.org">npld@neefusa.org</a> with any issues.





## Make sure to check the box!

To request fee-free coupons, you must check the "Would you like to receive fee-free coupons?" box when you register your event. Make sure to include the quantity and delivery address.





## Receive confirmation emails

After you register your event and request fee-free coupons, you will receive two emails: one confirming your event was registered and one confirming you requested fee-free coupons.





## Distribute fee-free coupons at your event

Coupon recipients will enjoy a day of fee-free access to participating public lands sites, including entrance and day use fees, for up to a year following National Public Lands Day (NPLD)
